



YOUR SAFETY AT THE SYMPOSIUM

The CSU Shiley Haynes Institute for Palliative Care is taking every step to ensure your safety when attending the 2022 National Symposium for Academic Palliative Care Education and Research.

- At check-in to the event, all in attendance will be required to present proof of full vaccination, *including booster*, OR proof of valid medical exemption AND negative COVID test no earlier than April 18, 2022.
- Name badges will be coded with your social distancing safety preference, so others in attendance can respect your distancing wishes.
- Meeting rooms and gathering spaces will set to allow for spacious, yet engaging interaction with others.
- Meals and breaks will be served in the large Regatta Pavilion, with outdoor seating options included.
- Hand sanitizer is being provided as a gift for all attendees by Elsevier Publishing.
- During the event, masks may be recommended pending local conditions and public health guidelines in April.
